# GENERAL

#### ALL COMPETITORS AND EXHIBITORS AT THE FAR SOUTH COAST NATIONAL SHOW COMPETE AT THEIR OWN RISK.

#### CHIEF RING STEWARD: Greg Grant

#### ENTRIES

(a) SHOWJUMPING EVENTS: Entries must be made with the Ring Secretary 2 hours before the commencement of the Event.

(b) DRESSAGE: Entries close at 12 NOON, MONDAY, 12th FEBRUARY 2018 with the Secretary and must be accompanied by a payment of \$15.00. Bega AP & H Society bank details are: National Australia Bank, Bega – BSB 082 439, Account Number: 50952 2979. NO LATE ENTRIES
(c) INSUFFICIENT ENTRIES: Where there are insufficient entries in any one class, the Judges may use their discretion and combine classes. Secretaries of local Breed Societies must be consulted where

applicable.

(d) OTHER EVENTS (Non-showjumping): Entry will be by means of tickets, which may be purchased at the Ring Secretary's Office at a cost of \$2.00 per ticket. Entry Fees shall be one ticket for events with Prizemoney up to \$10.00 and two tickets for events with Prizemoney over \$10.00. No refunds on unused tickets.

(e) IN EVENTS FOR PAIRS OR TEAMS OF HACKS: A single entry is required for each pair or team.

#### MEASURING

Measuring is available and will be carried out by officials from the A.P & H Society

#### **STABLING & CAMPING**

Stabling and camping for the period of the Show ONLY. Reservations for stables and campsites should be booked on-line after the 31 January 2018. Stables: Enclosed stables \$30, covered stables \$15, steel yards \$10, build-your-own \$5, for entire show. Camping: \$15/night or \$40 for entire show, per camp.

#### 20 PRIZEMONEY

(a) SHOWJUMPING EVENTS: Will be collected from the Ring Secretary on completion of event. Grading cards must be presented to the Ring Secretary before prizemoney can be collected.

(b) FOR ALL OTHER EVENTS: Will be paid on completion of the event. Separate presentations are to take place for Dressage.

#### COMPETITORS MUST CONFORM TO THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS OF DRESS

LADY'S ATTIRE: Hat, Jodhpurs or Breeches & Coat

GENTLEMAN'S ATTIRE: Hat or Cap, Jodhpurs or Breeches, Coat & Tie.

**SKULL CAPS & CHIN STRAPS EA** approved number shall be worn in all Hunting, Jumping & Sporting Events.

COAT is not necessary in Working Classes & Sporting Events Dress for led in classes must be neat and matching, including hat or cap and gloves. Clean sports shoes are acceptable.

SAFETY HELMETS and riding boots must be worn in fancy dress competitions.

#### ALL COMPETITORS SHALL ENTER AND LEAVE THE RING IN A DIGNIFIED MANNER

**NOMINATIONS** - The Society reserves the right to refuse any nomination

**RING** - No person will be allowed in the ring, with the exception of Stewards and Judges while a competition is in progress.

#### **REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES MUST** be produced on request.

The owners of any Horse, Galloway or Pony competing, must if called upon, produce a certificate of the animal's height. Every animal must be under thorough control. Stallions CANNOT compete in Ridden Classes, except in specified Classes - Showjumping and Breed

Classes. All Stallions must be bitted and green tagged.

No horse, either ridden or led, may enter any arena, other than the practice arena, except when actually competing in an event on penalty of disqualification.

**RESERVE CHAMPION** - When a Champion Ribbon has been awarded, the Competitor/Exhibitor placed second to the Champion in the preceding individual class shall then be eligible to come forward to compete for **RESERVE CHAMPION**, together with other first prize winners.

**NOVICE EVENTS** are open to any horse that has not been placed first at any Agricultural Show or similar event.

IN CASES WHERE EXHIBITORS' EVENTS CLASH, the competitors must choose between same, as classes will not be held up for latecomers. Any person using offensive language to Judges and Stewards, or any other person, may be disgualified by the Committee for such period of time as the Committee deems fit.

ALL PROTESTS against awards must be in writing and accompanied by a Fee of \$50, and must be lodged with the Secretary within one hour of the close of the event. The fee may be forfeited if the Committee considers the protest frivolous. In the event of any protest or disqualification being upheld the next award in order will substitute.

DRUGS - It is forbidden to administer any stimulant or depressant to a horse, or to cause one to be administered in any way whatsoever, either before the start of a competition, or on the previous day, under the maximum penalty of disqualification for life of the owner, rider, horse and groom. The Society may make or cause to be made any test of any exhibit to determine whether any drug or stimulant has been administered to such an exhibit and may take possession of any such exhibit for any of the aforesaid purposes and detain such horse for such period as is deemed necessary.

PARKING - Day parking is available for floats on Glebe Park adjacent to the lagoon. Truck and car parking is at the owner's risk.

CARS are NOT permitted to park on the Showground (except where written permission has been given by the Show President).

No alcohol or glass bottles to be brought onto the showground. Riding under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.

All competitors, strappers and others involved in the show must purchase and wear a wristband. Purchase of a wristband covers use of Showground facilities and ground entry. No one will be admitted to the showground or the arena unless they are WEARING a wristband. Charges made for stables, stalls & camping, see pages 13, 14, & 15. All electrical extension cords used by competitors camping on the grounds must have a current electrical test tag.

# WARNING: FLYING FOXES

Competitors in Horse Events at the show should be aware of the flying fox colony at the Glebe Lagoon, south of the Showground. They are close to Glebe Park where many competitors camp.

Flying Foxes are known to carry the Hendra Virus which can affect horses, dogs and humans. The virus is carried to the other species through body fluids of the flying fox - faeces, saliva and urine.

However, testing has shown that no Hendra Virus has been found in coastal NSW colonies (including the Bega Valley). It is confined to Queensland and the Northern Rivers of NSW.

However, horse owners camped at the Showground for the Show should take precautions such as general hygiene, the covering of feed and water vessels used by horses, especially at night time when the flying foxes are active.

Under no circumstances should campers in Glebe Park camp under or near the trees near the lagoon where the flying foxes roost. A barrier (fence) will be erected to indicate the boundary of the camping area near the lagoon.

#### The Keith Gordon Senior Showjumper of the Year Award The Graham Johnson Junior Showjumper of the Year Award Established in 2009

The Far South Coast Showjumper of the Year Series was initiated in 2009 to honour the memory of two devoted contributors to the local show circuit and the sport of showjumping. These awards will be presented to the horse and rider combination with the highest point score in showjumping events at shows on the Far South Coast.

#### **RULES**

1. Shows eligible for point scoring; The Bega Showjumping Cup, Pambula Show, Candelo Show, Eurobodalla Show, Cobargo Show, Far South Coast National Show-Bega and Bemboka Show.

2. There is NO minimum amount of shows that contestants are required to participate at to be eligible to score points.

3. EVERY showjumping event consisting of a **single horse** and **rider** entry in every ring will be counted towards the point score 4. For the purpose of this point score competition, the junior definition has followed suit of the EA Junior definition. The Junior definition for this competition will be:

5. **Junior definition:** All riders up to and including the calendar year in which they turn 18. (ie. if a participating rider turns 18 in the year the competition is taking place, they are an eligible junior. If they turned 18 the year before, they are a senior). Points will be awarded to the top three placegetters as follows;

- 1<sup>st</sup> = 3 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1 point

In the event of equal placings, the horse and rider combinations will take their awarded placing points (ie two in !st place take 3 points each and 3rd place takes 1 point)

6. Points will be awarded to the rider and horse as a COMBINATION. An individual horse can contest both the senior and junior category if the owner so wishes, as this will not affect the point score in anyway. Contestants must be reminded that the HORSES WELFARE must be paramount at all times.

7. Only the TWO (2) BEST PERFORMANCES of a horse & rider combination PER DAY (if applicable), PER SHOW will count towards the point score.

8. The top three placegetters will receive points in their category regardless of the type of event in which they place. ie. if a junior rider wins an open event the points will still go towards the Junior point score.

9. A running point score is to be printed in the local newspapers after each show. The overall winners will be announced after the Bemboka Show.

The 2018 Point score Committee nominated to handle enquires and disputes are 2 members of the Bega Showjumping Club. The overall winners of the Far South Coast Showjumper of The Year Series for 2018 will receive a trophy jacket and rug acknowledging their outstanding achievement.
